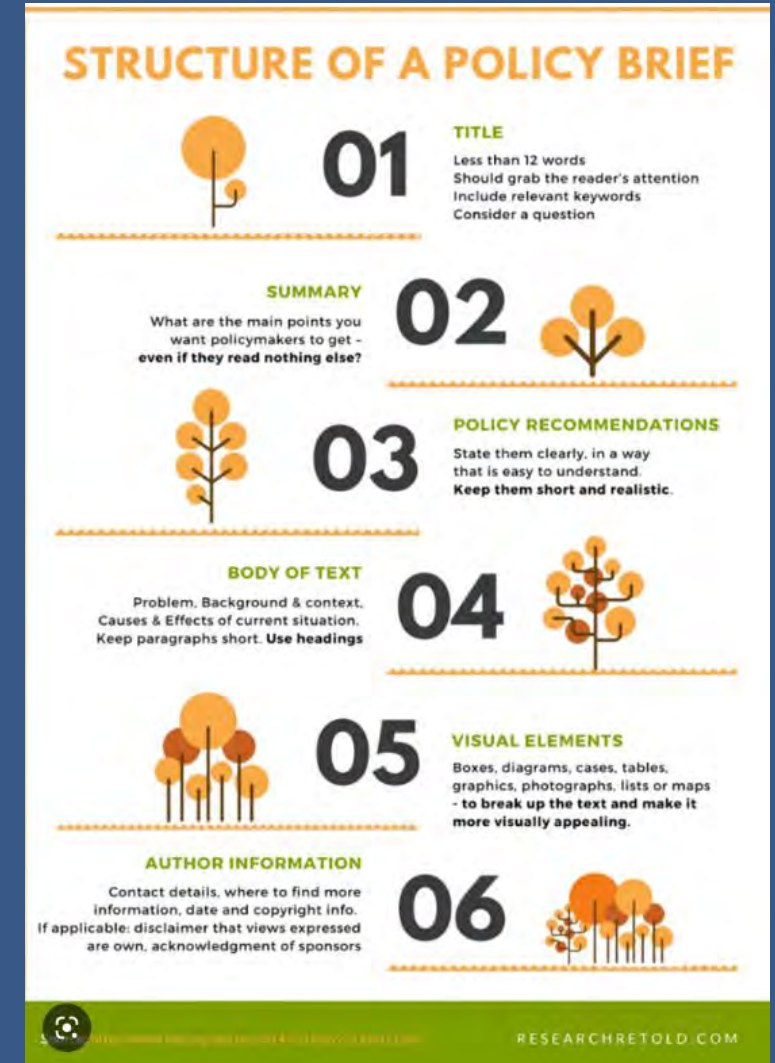
Fast Track to Vision 2030 publication – what , how, why

- A collection of **policy brief articles**
- Written by «our» researchers
- Edited and published by NorForsk
- To inform the process of making the new collaborative program for the last period of the Vision 2030



Content of articles

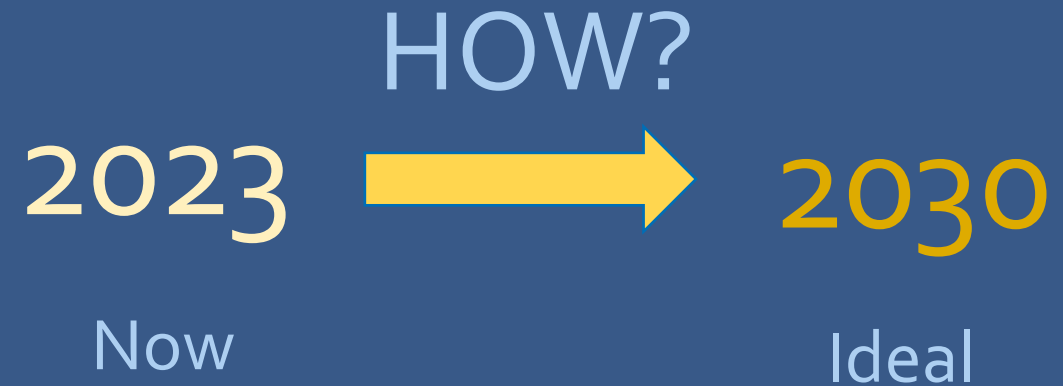
- Not a research article
- Use a language of popular science
- Try to engage and inform in a way that is meaningful when making priorities
- Give your opinion and recommendations relevant to your field of work
- Propose ambitious but realistic goals for Nordic cooperation and actions to achieve the Vision



Contents of articles

Based on your knowledge:

- What is the best way, what actions should we take, as a society, to reach the Vision by 2030?
- How should we cooperate in the Nordics to tackle threats and resolve challenges
- In what areas and /or sectors will Nordic cooperation be most important, i.e., have the highest Nordic added value?

Eligibility

- Original “policy brief” articles
- From Nordic project owners
- The main author must be leader of, or participate in, research projects granted funding from NordForsk or Nordic Energy Research.
- We encourage consortia to submit a joint article.



How to submit

- The call is open
- Our website, nordforsk.org
- **Read the call text**
- We need some information, fill in the form
- Upload 4 pages max , word file can include one editable illustration



Funding opportunities

We open calls continuously. On average, we have six calls per year.

Our calls are published on the website, on our application portal and in our newsletter.

Processing of articles

- No peer-review
- Eligibility check by NordForsk
- Articles will be proofread
- NordForsk reserves the right will make changes in layout as well as minor textual adjustments as a result of external proof reading
- Decision expected by August 2023
- Main authors will receive an email if article is accepted



Financial framework

- Call frame; up to 6 million NOK
- 50 000,- per article
- All accepted articles will be payed
- To institution of main author
- We will send a “grant letter” in September



Dissemination

- The Fast Track to Vision 2030 publication will be handed to the Nordic Council of Ministers Secretariat and the Nordic Council, September 2023
- Be published in the [DIVA portal](#)
- Be used in NordForsk and Nordic Energy research communication activities with stakeholders in the Nordic region, nationally, locally, in the EU, across sectors and policy areas in the years to come
